Dietary supplement for cats and small dogs

To reduce oxalate stone formation



Potassium citrate alkalises the urine. The urinary pH should not fall below 6.2.

The glycosaminoglycans (GAGs) **glucosamine** and **chondroitin** help maintain the protective layer of the bladder wall, which may be compromised in cases of GAG deficiency or irritation caused by urinary crystals.

Vitamin B₆ helps prevent increased oxalate formation associated with vitamin B₆ deficiency.

FeliGum® Oxal also contains **nettle extract** and **horsetail herb**.

FeliGum® Oxal has urine-alkalising properties, helping to reduce the recurrence of oxalate stones. At the same time, it promotes an increase in urine volume. FeliGum® Oxal also supplements the diet with nutrients that are important for maintaining the protective function of the urinary tract mucosa and should be supplied in adequate amounts.

Essential Nutritional Characteristics:

Low calcium content, low vitamin D content, urine-alkalising properties

Composition:

Meat and animal by-products, tripotassium citrate 15.5 %, sorbitol, glycerine, vegetable by-products (horsetail herb 1.3 %), glucosamine from animal tissue 3.3 %, oils and fats, chondroitin sulfate 2.6 %, minerals, yeasts

Feeding Recommendation:

Body Weight	Daily Amount
Up to 5 kg	½–1 chew, twice daily
>5–10 kg	2–4 chews, twice daily

Recommended Feeding Period:

Initially for up to 6 months.

It is recommended to seek the advice of a veterinarian before use. Do not exceed the recommended feeding amount. Do not use in animals with hyperkalaemia.

FeliGum® Oxal should preferably be administered with or immediately after feeding.

One chew contains 3,100 mg of potassium citrate.

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Notes:

A 160 g pouch contains approximately 80 palatable chews. Fresh drinking water should be available at all times. Store in a dry place below 25°C. Reseal the pouch tightly after use.
