Alpine grass meal provides valuable natural plant compounds and forms the high-quality base of the bites. The combination of nasturtium and horseradish is characterised by its content of glucosinolates. The isothiocyanates released from these compounds are well known for their antimicrobial properties and have traditionally been valued for supporting the body's natural defence mechanisms, thereby contributing to overall resilience. Propolis complements the formulation with valuable bioactive compounds and helps support normal immune function.

The bites are gently cold-pressed to preserve their valuable ingredients as effectively as possible. Their highly palatable recipe allows them to be fed easily as a tasty reward and ensures excellent acceptance. The dust-free, fibre-rich formulation also supports natural tooth wear. In addition, **RodiCare® Immun Bites** are free from grains, added sugar, and preservatives.

Alpine grass meal 45.0 %, rose hips, Echinacea spp., common boneset herb, thyme, Siberian ginseng, nasturtium 5.0 %, Iceland moss, mint, shilajit, propolis 2.2 %, dried sage leaves, horseradish root 0.25 %

Crude protein 11.2 %, crude fat 1.8 %, crude fibre 27.2 %, crude ash 7.5 %, calcium 1.3 %, phosphorus 0.35 %, sodium 0.2 %

Pet rabbits: 2 bites

Dwarf rabbits, guinea pigs: 1 bite
