With calamus and ginger



RodiCare® Appetit enriches a herb-deficient diet with calamus, gentian, and wormwood, as well as flavorful aromatic compounds [ginger tincture and black pepper extract], thereby stimulating the appetite.



Loss of appetite in rabbits, guinea pigs, and small rodents must be taken very seriously.

Due to their fast metabolism, they can quickly fall into an energy deficit, which may negatively impact liver health.

In guinea pigs and rabbits, even a few hours without food can lead to digestive disturbances with potentially serious consequences.

Animals that stop eating should always be taken to a veterinarian to determine the underlying cause of the appetite loss.

Composition:

Dextrose 15%, [Calamus root, wormwood herb, gentian root] macerated 1.5% each, Calamus root 0.1%, Wormwood herb 0.1%, Gentian root 0.05%

Analytical constituents:

Additives per 1000 ml:

Flavouring substances:

Ginger tincture	15 ml
Black pepper extract	0,4 ml

Recommended duration of use:

2–5 days

Notes:

Fresh water and good quality hay should always be freely available.

Shake before use!

Rinse the syringe after use.

Store below 25 °C and protect from light.

Use after opening.

Feeding recommendation:

Administer over food or directly into the mouth.

Depending on body weight, 1–3 × daily:

Mouse, hamster: 0.05 ml

Rat: 0.1 ml

Guinea pig, dwarf rabbit: 0.2–0.3 ml

Rabbit: 0.4–0.6 ml
