Herbal pellets



A very high crude fiber content supports the maintenance of healthy gut flora and promotes intestinal peristalsis.

Fenugreek seeds, calamus root, and turmeric stimulate appetite and digestive activity.

Chamomile flowers, peppermint, fennel seeds, caraway seeds, and licorice enrich the diet with valuable secondary plant compounds.



The most common cause of digestive disorders in guinea pigs and rabbits is feeding errors. In particular, a lack of crude fiber leads to insufficient tooth wear and dysbiosis, which can result in diarrhea, constipation, and bloating (tympany). Additionally, very few wild herbs—which naturally stimulate digestion—are included in their diets today.

RodiCare® basic is a pelleted feed specially formulated for guinea pigs and rabbits. Its high crude fiber content promotes healthy digestion and forms the nutritional foundation for essential gut flora.

RodiCare® basic contains all essential vitamins and minerals. With its high vitamin C content, it ensures adequate supply even for guinea pigs that temporarily do not receive fresh food.

In addition, RodiCare® basic enhances an herb-deficient diet with a carefully selected herbal blend that supports digestion and stimulates appetite.

Composition:

Linseed meal 20.6%, oat bran 20%, green meal 15%, dried apple pomace 14%, sunflower meal 6%, barley 5%, beet molasses 4%, lignocellulose (softwood) 2.5%, parsley 2%, pineapple powder 1%, mint 1%, caraway seed 1%, red bell pepper 1%, sodium chloride 0.7%, flaxseed 0.5%, fenugreek seed 0.5%, licorice root 0.5%, turmeric 0.5%, calamus root 0.5%, fennel seed 0.5%, dried chamomile flowers 0.5%

Vitamin A [3a672a] 7,000 IU, Vitamin D3 [3a671] 500 IU, Vitamin E 110 mg, Vitamin C 1,000 mg, Iron as iron(II) sulfate monohydrate [3b103] 40 mg, Manganese as manganese(II) oxide [3b502] 50 mg, Zinc as zinc oxide [3b603] 74 mg, Copper as copper(II) sulfate, pentahydrate [3b405] 15 mg, Selenium as sodium selenite [3b801] 0.3 mg, Iodine as calcium iodate, anhydrous [3b202] 1.1 mg, Molybdenum as sodium molybdate (E7) 0.2 mg, Cobalt as coated cobalt(II) carbonate granules [3b304] 0.4 mg

Feeding recommendation:

Guinea pigs:

Adult animals receive approx. 30 g/day (1½ measuring scoops).

Dwarf rabbits:

Adult animals receive approx. 50 g/day (2½ measuring scoops).

The required feeding amount may vary depending on species, weight, age, and condition of the animal.

The exact amount should be determined based on observation or consultation with a veterinarian.

Recommended feeding duration: At least 20–30 days.

RodiCare® basic can also be used long-term as a supplement to high-quality hay and fresh food.

Notes: Fresh water and high-quality hay should always be freely available.

Any sudden change in diet should be avoided!

Any additional fresh food should be rich in structure and introduced in very small amounts at first, then gradually increased.

Store in a dry place below 25 °C.
